Midland National Life opens new facility

FEBRUARY 12, 2009 - SIOUX FALLS, SD - After 30 years at its downtown location, Midland National Life Insurance Co. will move to its new facility over President's Day weekend, February 13-16. The 120,000 square foot building, designed by Koch Hazard Architects, is located at the Interstate Crossing Business Park in southwest Sioux Falls.

The new two-story office building features a linear atrium that acts as the main circulation spine. The design incorporates geothermal energy, under floor air and electrical distribution and an open structural grid to maximize flexibility. A double pond marks the entry to the new campus which includes a third pond that accents the exterior plaza, a walking path, native plantings and future expansion area.

"We do expect growth. We expect growth in the business. We expect growth in head count. Our new facility will comfortably hold in excess of 600 employees," said Rob TeKolste, executive vice president for operations.

"It's truly going to be a gorgeous, functional work environment for our employees," TeKolste said.
